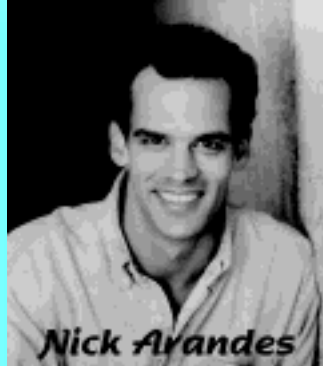

Chapter II THE MYTH OF RISK

PART ONE

Ask yourself the following questions.

1. Is my life filled with joy, happiness, prosperity, health, abundance and freedom?
2. Are all my dreams and material desires fulfilled?
3. Is my life filled with harmonious personal relationships, including family and friends?
4. Do I believe in that Infinite Wisdom that created me and provides everything I need in order to live a life filled with joy, happiness and prosperity?
5. Do I TRUST, in that Infinite Wisdom?

If you answered "yes" to all the questions asked you are acting based on your true nature. However, If your answer was either "no," or "part of my life is working and part of it is not," you may be afraid of the myth called risk. Most people say yes, when asked if they believe in God or a Higher Power. The key question is: Do they trust in that Power? Do they trust in that infinite intelligence that created us and provides everything we need for the fulfillment of our heart's desires?

This is extremely important because it will allow us to understand the true meaning of the word "risk". When we were born, we were meant to live a life filled with love, joy, peace, prosperity, radiant health and harmonious relationships, not because these are things we were meant to acquire through some kind of hard work or strenuous effort, but because those characteristics are part of our true nature. Unfortunately most of us have forgotten who we are. We have bought into the social hypnosis which says that all we are is a physical body filled with limitations and we have confined ourselves to the prison of our self imposed limiting ideas about ourselves and about life.

A lot of people live a life filled with lack and limitation because they fear risk. Fortunately, risk does not exist on a truly spiritual level. It is only an illusion we have collectively fabricated. The universe express itself through our hearts, not through our intellect. I am not implying that there is anything wrong with the

intellect. But we must remember that the intellect is in the mind, it has to do with understanding and reasoning, from the acquisition of knowledge. Therefore, in order for it to be useful, it has to be based on absolute truth. We can rationalize literally anything just to fit our limited perception of how things should be.

When we follow our heart's desires, when we listen to our INTUITION, there are no risks involved because the intuition already knows the truth. Even when the physical level of existence reflects just the opposite, we are safe. That is the true meaning of trusting ourselves. Remember that when you have an intuitive signal, it means that all the pieces of the puzzle have been properly arranged. That is something that the mind cannot figure out. The conflict begins when our capacity for reasoning, "our intellect," gets in the way. When we try to figure things out, we get scared because we are unable to see the whole picture. So instead of listening to our inner voice, we listen to the voice of fear. The mind tries to see the map while your heart already knows it. Therefore it is telling you, "follow my guidance. I have already lay it all out for you. All I want you to do is to trust me and move. Believe me, "you are safe."

The voice of fear is full of judgment, definitions and labels that people have created for the sole purpose of justifying and trying to find a meaning out of everything that happens on the material level of existence. If someone cannot calculate it, measure it or rationally understand it, then most people automatically begin to think that it must be an illusion. It probably does not exist. What people must understand is that the illusion is the physical level of existence. Because of the fact that through our physical senses we can immediately access the material level, it only reinforces the illusion we live in. In order to get in touch with our true self, (the spiritual self), in order to tap into that infinite source of happiness and fulfillment, we have to transcend.

When we transcend from the physical to the spiritual level, where there are no judgments, labels or definitions, we become more trusting. When we begin to listen to our own intuition, the path of success, love, happiness and true freedom begins to unfold before our own eyes. Highly successful people have come to the realization that they are not alone, and that there is an infinite guidance that leads them where they want to go and helps them achieve their desires. That is why they are not afraid to take risks, because they understand the fact that they are guided by a Divine wisdom that only speaks through the heart.

This Divine Spirit can neither be measured nor calculated. You can only feel it. The more you learn to trust your Higher Self the more you realize that risk is only a myth. The only way you can proof to yourself the validity of what I have just said is by taking immediate action.

The following short story entitled THE DARK ROOM, will provide a better understanding of what I have been saying. In the story:

1. The individual represents our own self.
2. The dark room represents a present job, a dissatisfying personal relationship, any particular situation that we need to change in our lives but are afraid to take a step forward.
3. The feeling or (intuition) that the individual in the story receives comes from the infinite wisdom. It represents true knowledge.
4. Doors A & B represent choices and their respective signs serve the sole purpose of challenging the intellect.

Imagine a dark room where there is an individual sitting on a chair facing two separate doors-door A and door B. Door A has a sign that reads, "If you can not handle what is on the other side, it can destroy you." Door B has a sign that reads, "There is something powerful on the other side."

This individual has three choices:

1. He can go through door A.
2. He can go through door B
3. He can stay where he is.

The challenge is that he is very unhappy inside that room. He wants to get out but he is afraid to take the chance. On the other side of door A, where the sign reads, "If you can not handle what is on the other side it can destroy you," there is a suitcase with \$1,000,000 inside. Behind door B, where the sign reads, "There is something powerful on the other side," there is a hungry tiger that can tear him apart in seconds.

This person begins to figure out what to do. In other words, he is trying to intellectualize his choices. As he glances at door A he gets a strong feeling, an urge to go for it. Because of fear and doubt generated by his intellect he decides to wait. Instead of acting upon his intuition, he refers to his reasoning because he wants to play it safe. He finally decides to go through door B where there is something powerful, as opposed to door A where he may take the chance of not being able to handle what is on the other side, even when that is what his intuition told him. Relying only on the faculties of the mind can sometimes lead us to make decisions based on fear. In this particular case a rational decision not based on fact but on a simple perception directed him to make a choice that cost him far more than what he would have expected.

As you can see, your intuition already knows what is on the other side of any door you may be presented with. It knows the truth. It wants only the best for you. So when you follow your heart, you are not taking a risk at all. You are not moving

from the secure to the insecure. You are moving from the familiar to the unfamiliar. The unfamiliar does not mean that it is unsafe. It simply means that it is a new experience for you. On the other hand, if you do not listen to your higher self and decide to figure things out on your own, then you are taking a risk. So hurry up and finish this book so that you can begin to move in the direction of your dreams. Your dreams are not waiting for you to chase them, they are simply waiting for you to move so they can greet you.

You have to realize that the guarantee for a happy and successful living has already been granted the moment you were born. The only thing required is to TRUST.

LESSONS TO BE LEARNED

Chapter V

THE MAGIC OF YOUR BELIEFS

"If you believe it, it is true for you"

Yes, beliefs are like magic, because in order for us to manifest things in our lives, we must believe. I realize it sounds simple, and believe me, it is very simple. Living life with this philosophy does not have to be difficult. After all, we were born that way. It is the way life was meant to be. To love and be loved, to enjoy, to achieve our dreams, to have our needs met.

The Universe wants to fulfill all of our desires. But what needs to be understood is that in order for us to live this kind of life, we must eliminate all sense of doubt we have incorporated into our belief system throughout the years. All that F.E.A.R. meaning "false evidence appearing real" -- and the tendency to focus on it -- is what creates conflict in people's lives.

A lot of individuals who see a therapist are very good at complaining about the things that are not working in their lives. Instead of working towards a solution, they are too busy focusing on the problem, and consequently, they experience more of the problem. The reason this is important is because the mechanics of creation simply listens to our request and begins immediately to execute our command. And the command is based on our beliefs. So if a person believes that his or her life is not working, what do you think that individual is going to create? Circumstances that will justify his or her point. So we must be aware of what we are creating at all times.

I used the word magic instead of power in naming this chapter because beliefs are extremely powerful--almost mystical. At one point they were very difficult to explain at a purely physical level. Now with Quantum Physics most of this phenomena can be explained and even measured. For example, there was a time when it was thought that the universe was a combination of matter separated by empty space. Now science has come to the realization that what appears to be an empty space between matter is nothing but a field of energy and information. The

seeming empty space between you and I, regardless whether we are in opposite parts of the globe, is a field of energy and information where the primordial components of matter lies. In other words, you and I are individualized expressions of the field which has taken physical form while the seeming empty space is the potential for anything to manifest into physical form. So whether it may appear to you that we are separated because we are in different parts of the world, the fact that we are made of the same source, and that source is the invisible space between you and I, the truth is, we are connected. The great masters such as Christ, Buddha, as well as many others, they all knew that there is no separation, even when that is what appears to the naked eye. They knew that we are all connected for we are all expressions of the very same source.

The way we can affect the behavior of the field is through our conscious awareness of it. Our beliefs are very powerful and holds the key to influence the field. Teachings like "it will be done unto you according to your faith," or "...even the least among you can do the works that I do and even greater works than these," [John 14:12], are based on the power of your beliefs. Through their teachings and examples like the miracles of Jesus The Christ, we have been taught that we have the potential within us to become miracle makers. Regardless of what science may say they have discovered, the truth is that there is nothing new to discover. All we have to do is to recognize who we really are. We are the pure potentiality to manifest anything we want. And our beliefs holds the key to unlock that potential.

I will attempt to illustrate what my understanding about beliefs are. If you are wondering how I know all this is true, it is because I have experienced it. The only way you will truly understand what I am about to explain is through your own personal experience. If you must see something in order to believe it, then in order to manifest something in your life, you would have to see it first. The problem here becomes obvious. If you want something but cannot see it, how can you possibly believe it? And if you cannot believe it because you cannot see it, how can you possibly manifest it?

As you can see, believing begins the process of creation. Once you create in your mind a clear vision of your dream, and truly believe in the attainment of it, two things automatically happen. First, your mind begins directing your body towards immediate action aimed at manifesting your vision. And second, the spiritual core of your being -- call it God, Higher Self, Higher Consciousness, Subconscious Mind, Universe or whatever you choose -- will orchestrate all the necessary details by providing you with opportunities and circumstances that will allow you to easily manifest your heart's desires.

If you sometimes wonder why the things you desire most have not been manifested in your life, the answer is very simple. Life wants us to have it all. It wants us to fulfill our dreams. But when the things we desire most are not in our best interest, at least not at that particular moment, we meet with a lot of resistance. Sometimes it

seems as if the Universe does not want to make our wishes come true. That does not mean you will not get what you want. You can still get what you want, but you will really have to fight for it. As a result of struggling you may end up with your particular goal along with a few bonuses such as high blood pressure, stress or even a heart attack.

That is what is meant by easily and effortless accomplishment. When we are in flow, meaning not fighting the current, we always seem to be at the right place at the right time. The only way we can become part of the flow is through the process called surrendering. It simply means that when we let go of whatever result we are seeking we are allowing the Universe to orchestrate all the events, trusting that the fulfillment of our desires is in process. That opens up the space not only for our desires, but for something even better to manifest in our lives. And when our desire is ready, it will come to us easily and effortlessly.

For example, have you ever wanted to meet someone and when you least expect it you run into that person? Maybe you wanted to go on a trip, and you held that thought in your head so persistently that somebody ended up inviting you or an opportunity fell right on your lap. Or you wanted to go to a sold out game, and out of the blue, someone with an extra ticket called to invite you. It is as though you become a magnet, attracting people and events that can help you attain your dreams. All you have to do is believe in your vision. We have done this all our lives, but instead of giving ourselves credit for becoming the creators of our destiny, we dismiss all those events as coincidences.

Detachment to a specific result allows us to stay focused in the present moment. Like the old paradox says, when your mind is focusing on the outcome you are no longer in the process, but when your mind is focused in the process the outcome is guaranteed!

I'd like to share with you a personal life experience so that I can illustrate my point. I had been wanting to move to Los Angeles, CA for the last several years. When I finally made the decision back in 1992, I had a few opportunities but every time I pursued them something would happen that would not allow me to leave. Back then I was in the process of writing my first manuscript of a book. In December, 1992 and January 1993, my book was in the early stages of editing. Even when my financial situation was really challenging, I was always able to keep working on it.

I did not have a computer or a type writer. I was doing everything on pen and paper. In February a friend of mine asked me if I was interested in renting an apartment in Los Angeles. (Is that not what I wanted?) I accepted and paid to hold it for two months. Unfortunately, I could not keep paying the rent because financially I hit bottom. (Resistance) I was broke. I even considered filing for bankruptcy.

I never gave up the idea of moving to Los Angeles. I simply understood that there

must be a reason why my dream could not be manifested at that time. (Surrender) That same month, I went to a local comedy club in Miami, Florida. After my performance, the entertainment coordinator for a major cruise line saw me and asked me to call him at his office the next day. Working for the cruise line, they not only took care of all my travel expenses but I was generating between \$800 to \$1,400 a week in income.

Around July of that same year, my grandmother in Puerto Rico became very ill. Because the cruise line had ships in Puerto Rico, they would fly me back and forth between Miami and Puerto Rico so that I could visit my grandmother. Most of the time I would stay in Puerto Rico where I would join a ship for a couple of days and they would fly me back.

In October, my grandmother passed away and I had to take care of the funeral arrangements. Because I am an only child and my mother had died five years prior to my grandmother, all of a sudden I was overwhelmed with many responsibilities. Thanks to the cruise line, I could still make money while I was taking care of things at home in Puerto Rico.

That same month I got a call from a production company in West Palm Beach, Florida telling me that 20th Century Fox was interested in me for a television pilot. 20th Century Fox put me on a holding deal for \$30,000. If I had moved to Los Angeles when I wanted to, it would have been difficult for me to handle the financial responsibilities that came my way.

As you can see, everything in life follows a perfect order. God wants the best for us. The Universe knew all the challenges I was going to face that particular year. But my dream was never denied. Besides, how could it possible be denied when it is not really me dream. It is God's dream. I am just the channel, just as you are, through which desires are transmuted into physical experience. All that was required from me at that moment was to move in the direction of my dream. So what is your dream? Do not concern yourself with details regarding how to make it happen because that is none of your business. Notice how the Universe made my dream come true in a way that I was not even expecting. Not only did I end up moving to California, but I moved with plenty of money in my pocket, a development deal and a manuscript.

Before closing I want you to be aware that when I mentioned earlier in the chapter that I was broke, I could have easily said poor. The reason I chose the words broke as opposed to poor, is because a person who is broke understands that he or she can figure out a way to generate income. On the other hand, someone who is poor has made a decision to remain that way. Poverty has nothing to do with economy or circumstances, it is a state of mind. Believe it or not, it is a personal decision. So be aware of how you talk to yourself.

In January of 1993 I was completely broke financially, ready to file bankruptcy. I had no work lined up, but by the end of that year I had made an annual income of \$44,000. I traveled all over the Caribbean with all expenses paid, I got to stay in Puerto Rico with my grandmother, I ended up with a \$30,000 development deal with 20th Century Fox and relocated to Los Angeles, California. That's the MAGIC of your beliefs!

At this point, the mechanic begins to swear and blame God for all that is happening to him. He does not realize that it is all his fault for not taking care of his car the way he should have.

WHAT THE STORY MEANS

The car represents our physical body. It doesn't matter what this body looks like on the outside because our differences is what makes us unique. What is important is that if we want this body to be good to us, we have to be good to it. We have to take good care of it.

When people fill their bodies with improper food, alcohol, cigarettes or any kind of drugs, they are taking the risk that someday it will create some kind of disease that will make them unable to continue living a healthy life, or any life.

That is why when people end up with an illness at the peak of their career or in the middle of major accomplishments, they wonder how this could happen to them. They love to blame God for their misery, not realizing they are the ones who created it by the way they treated themselves, (the brand new race car given to them at the moment of birth).

People have to understand that that is what free choice is all about. We have been given the freedom to make our own choices, therefore is our responsibility to take proper care of ourselves **PHYSICALLY, MENTALLY and SPIRITUALLY**.

Along with free choice, we were also provided with everything we need to properly maintain this precious gift. All that is required from us, is to take good care of ourselves so that we can begin helping others to do the same for themselves.

If You happen to know of anyone who may be facing a challenging physical illness, here are three outstanding physicians I definitely recommend. The first is Dr. Deepak Chopra, M.D. He was born and raised in New Delhi, India. The son of a prominent cardiologist he attended the prestigious All India School of Medical Science and embarked on a career in western medicine. After graduating, he moved to the United States and completed residencies in internal medicine and endocrinology. He taught at Tufts University and Boston University Schools of Medicine. Dr. Chopra became a chief of staff at the New England Memorial Hospital establishing a large private practice. However, during this time, despite his apparent success, he noticed a growing lack of fulfillment and the nagging question, "Am I doing all I can for my patients?"

It was these doubts which led him to Ayurveda, the ancient science of healing from India. Dr. Chopra immediately realized that here was a system of health care that actually treated the whole person; a system whose guiding principles is that the mind exerts the deepest influence on the body.

Freedom from sickness and aging depends on finding that all important balanced awareness within. He did not abandon his earlier conventional training but extended it to bring together the best of the ancient wisdom and modern science.

In 1992 he was appointed to the ad. Hoc Panel on Alternative Medicine at the

National Institute of Health. In 1993 he became Executive Director of the Institute for Human Potential and Mind/Body Medicine and the chief executive consultant to the Center of Mind Body Medicine, a unique health care facility for stress management and behavioral medicine offering preventive and rejuvenative therapies and complementary treatments for chronic disorders.

As an international expert in mind/body medicine he travels widely giving lectures and seminars and has appeared on major television and radio shows throughout the world.

His Books including *Creating Health*, *Quantum Healing*, *Perfect Health*, *Unconditional Life*, *Ageless Body*, *Timeless Mind*, *Creating Affluence* and *The Seven Spiritual Laws Of Success*, have already been translated into more than twenty five different languages and his audio tape series have been widely acclaimed.

The second Physician is Dr. Bernie S. Siegel, M.D., the author of several best sellers including, *How To Live Between Office Visits*, *Peace, Love & Healing* and *Love, Medicine and Miracles*, is a surgeon in New Hampshire and teaches at Yale University. He is also the founder of ECaP (Exceptional Cancer Patients), a specialized form of individual and group therapy based on "carefrontation," a loving, safe, therapeutic confrontation that facilitates personal change and healing.

Dr. Siegel's remarkable experience led to his desire to make everyone aware of their own healing potential. In 1988, he became president of the American Holistic Medical Association. The last but not least Dr. Andrew Weil, M.D., He is a graduate of Harvard Medical School. Dr. Weil has worked for the National Institute of Mental Health and was for fifteen years a Research Associate in Ethnopharmacology at the Harvard Botanical Museum.

He is the author of the #1 National best seller *Spontaneous Healing*, *Natural Health*, *Natural Medicine: A Comprehensive Manual for Wellness and Self-Care*, *Health and Healing*, *From Chocolate to Morphine: Everything You Need To Know About Mind-Altering Drugs*, (with Winifred Rosen), *The Marriage of the Sun and Moon: A Quest for Unity in Consciousness*, and *The Natural Mind: A New Way of Looking at Drugs and the Higher Consciousness*.
